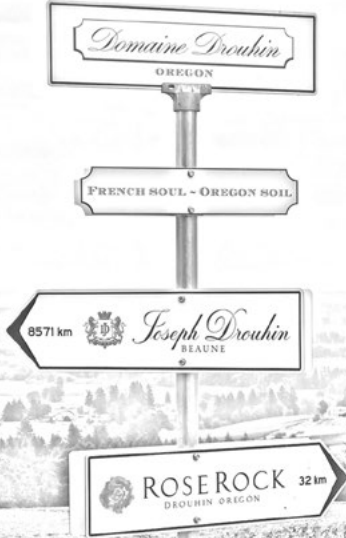

TERMS & CONDITIONS OF SALE 2025

These Terms and Conditions of Sale (the “Auction Terms”), and the documents identified herein, constitute the entire terms and conditions with respect to the sale and purchase of wines made available during the Willamette Valley Wineries Association (“WVWA”) The Wine Auction (the “Auction”). No agent, representative, or employee of WVWA shall have the right to waive or modify any of the Auction Terms set forth herein unless such person is an authorized representative of WVWA. By bidding, whether personally or through a proxy, the bidder agrees to be bound by these Auction Terms. WVWA reserves the right to amend these Auction Terms at any time via addendum or via oral announcements by a WVWA authorized representative during the Auction.

The Online Auction will open at auction.Zachys.com on May 12 at 10:00am PT and will close in three batches on May 14 at 4:05pm, 4:10pm, and 4:15pm PT for online-only bidding.

The Trade Auction will be open for absentee bidding from May 12 at 10:00am PT to May 15 at 1:00pm PT at auction.Zachys.com. The in-person live auction takes place on May 15 beginning at 1:00pm PT at Domaine Serene.

On May 15, only licensed members of the trade, their guests, and guests of WVWA, each of whom must be registered in advance, will be allowed admission to the Auction or participate in the Auction. All bidders must be licensed members of the wine trade who have registered as a bidder and received a numbered paddle. The WVWA will provide bidder contact information to Zachys Wine Auctions, Inc. which will operate the sale.

All statements of any nature, whether written or oral, by auctioneer, WVWA, or producing winery about any aspect of the auctioned wines are merely statements of opinion and do not in any way constitute a warranty or representation, either express or implied, concerning the quality of the wine or any other aspect of the wine. Such statements are not to be relied upon by bidders as warranties or representations of fact. Prospective bidders, by so bidding, acknowledge that they have inspected the wines to their satisfaction and bid only on the basis of their own inspection, evaluation and opinion

of the wine being sold. All wine is sold “as is” and without any warranty whatsoever, whether express or implied, including, but not limited to, warranties of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose.

The highest bidder for each wine when the bidding is closed, as determined by the auctioneer, will be recorded as the purchaser of the wine. WVWA will be the seller and retains sole discretion as to when and how to release the wine for delivery to the purchaser. Purchaser has no right to assign or otherwise transfer the right to take possession of the wine to any other party without first obtaining permission of WVWA, who may grant or withhold permission in its sole discretion.

Bids will be accepted only from registered bidders or a bidder’s designated agent and may only be made by numbered paddle issued by WVWA to that bidder. WVWA may rely on the authority of the designated agent(s) to act on behalf of bidder, and bidder shall hold WVWA harmless from any action taken by the designated bidder.

WVWA and the auctioneer shall have the right to reject any bid at any time prior to the fall of the hammer. No bid shall be valid unless acknowledged by the auctioneer. Should a dispute arise between bidders or should the auctioneer doubt the validity of any bid the auctioneer shall have the sole and absolute right to resolve the dispute, re-offer, or withdraw the lot in question.

At the fall of the hammer, the bidder identified by the auctioneer shall be deemed to have purchased the wine and thereupon assumes full risk and responsibility thereof. WVWA shall have the absolute right to withhold release and delivery of the wine to purchaser until purchaser has paid in full. Purchaser’s sole remedy for non-delivery of the wine shall be limited to obtaining a refund of the purchase price.

Bidders and purchasers agree that the sale and delivery of wines via the Auction shall not affect the rights of the producing winery to sell their own wines to any distributor of their choosing or direct to consumers in bidder’s/purchaser’s state or the right of producing winery to sell wines to any purchaser in said state. Bidder/purchaser agrees to take whatever steps are necessary to protect the rights of the producing winery outlined in this paragraph, including but not limited to the relinquishment of any rights which bidder/purchaser may have under state law.

Any offer or sale, as well as any action or proceeding, related to or in connection with the Auction shall be governed by and interpreted under the laws of the State of Oregon. Any offer or sale of wine related to or in connection with the Auction is subject to the provisions of the Oregon Liquor Control Act and Federal Alcohol Administration Act and are offered and sold subject to the provisions of those laws.

*Online Auction:
Online bidding is hosted by Zachys Wine Auctions. The Auction will be held subject to the terms and conditions of the host of the online Auction; provided, however, that these Auction Terms control the relationship between WVWA and bidders in the event of any conflicting term of the online Auction host. By participating in the online Auction, bidders agree to be bound by the terms and conditions and other published policies of the online Auction host.*

*Payment and Collection for Online Auction Buyers:
Purchaser will submit full payment for all purchases directly to Zachys Wine Auctions for each wine upon the close of the Online Auction. All bidders must submit credit card information to permit Zachys Wine Auctions to charge the bidder’s credit card for wine purchased in accordance with their terms and conditions. Lots paid with a credit card will incur a 2% processing fee. View Zachys Wine Auctions terms and conditions.*

*Payment and Collection for Trade Auction Buyers:
All wine trade bidders will receive an invoice for their purchases from the WVWA. Purchaser will submit full payment for all purchases directly to WVWA for each wine upon receipt of invoice. Only one payment per lot is permitted. Lots paid with a credit card will incur a 3.75% processing fee. Any amount not paid within 30 days of invoice will accrue interest at 1.5% per month.*

*Delivery:
All wine is sold FOB the location of the winery that produced the lot purchased. WVWA is not responsible for shipping wine. Shipping or delivery arrangements, expenses and insurance are the sole responsibility of the purchaser. Any shipment of wines out-of-state is the responsibility of the purchaser, who is solely responsible for compliance with the laws and regulations of said state.*

*Media Coverage:
As a condition of participating in the Auction, participant permits WVWA to reproduce, adapt, display, publish and distribute, in any and all media whether now known or yet to be developed, any video, photograph, or image taken or recorded of the participant at the Auction, participant’s name, voice, likeness, city or state of residence, and any other information regarding his/her participation in the Auction, and releases WVWA from any liability therefrom.*

2023 Pinot Noir | Terra Rouge

THE WINE. In the highest reaches of our Red Hills Vineyard lies the source of Terra Rouge, where Jory soils reach their most intense crimson hue. Here, the iron-rich volcanic earth has weathered to a deeper red than anywhere else on our estates in the Dundee Hills. Mature vines, rooted deep in this rust-colored soil, are perfectly positioned with southern exposure to harness the sun’s warmth. This combination of intensely red soils, optimal aspect, and vine age creates a unique wine that captures the very soul of the Dundee Hills - powerful yet elegant, and remarkably complex.

THE WINERY. In 1993, Archery Summit set its sights on creating wines of real purpose in the Willamette Valley. Since, the Dundee Hills winery has helped establish the region as the cradle of cooler-climate American wine. Winemaker Ian Burch and his team achieve bar-raising wines by way of earned instincts—the familiarity gained from many shared vintages, tending sites they know personally. Thirty years on, Archery Summit proudly considers itself the stewards of someplace truly special, with unparalleled potential. The winegrowing stresses organic and biodynamic farming, with zero tolerance for herbicide, nurturing the land and yielding a rousing lineup of estate Pinot Noirs.

THE WINE. Brilliant, pale golden in color with a silver edge, the nose first opens with aromas of white peaches in honey, Meyer lemons and orange curd, with hints of fresh chamomile and toasted hazelnuts. Fresh and lively on the palate, the wine shows a refreshingly light creamy texture that help bring and sustain the vibrant citrus flavors with undertones of minerality all the way through the palate. Elegant, complex and long, yet light on its feet and delicate, this is a classic example of how our chardonnay can bring together harmonious yet vibrant flavors sustained all the way through, so enjoyable on its own now, but which promises to age beautifully.

THE WINERY. Aubaine is a high end boutique project of single vineyard and estate only Chardonnay and Pinot Noir from the Eola-Amity Hills. Our founder Andy Lytle has teamed up with esteemed wine-maker Isabelle Meunier to make the best possible expression of the Eola-Amity Hills. Aubaine is the French term for Windfall. The green wave on the label represents the Eola-Amity Hills, and the blue wave represents the winds of the VanDuzer Corridor.

2023 Pinot Noir | *Trio of Pinot*

THE WINE. The three wines that comprise this blend of Pinot Noir delightfully represent the Willamette Valley in that the grapes were sourced from Albany, Aurora, and Sherwood Oregon. By blending them together we get to experience how the subtle differences in location can compliment one another beautifully.

THE WINERY. Aurora Vineyards’ vines sit in a variety of sun exposures with the original 17 acres of vines facing east/west and the new 2022 vines facing north/south. Our soil was deposited by the glacial flow from the Missoula Floods at the end of the last ice age. The soil is a sandy with very little clay, making for excellent drainage. The original 17 acres of vineyards are dry farmed, meaning we use only nature to water the vines. The 2022 vines will receive additional irrigation for 1-2 years to help them establish and then will also be dry farmed.

2023 Pinot Noir | *El Niño*

THE WINE. Beautifully capturing the dual significance behind this wine, emphasizing both the natural influence of the weather and the personal connection of the winemaker. This wine was born of a unique, “El Niño” weather cycle, which deeply impacts the character and quality of the wine. But the name “El Niño” also carries a personal and philosophical layer for winemaker, Amael Orrego. He compares his role in nurturing the wine to that of a parent raising a child. Just as he guides his daughters, setting gentle boundaries and helping them reach their fullest potential, he sees his job with the wine as one of nurturing and careful oversight. He shapes its journey, but ultimately allows nature—like a child’s development—to take its own course, trusting in its ability to reach its best expression.

Block B1 has consistently been a standout at the estate. The wine opens with vibrant notes of dark cherry and pomegranate, combined with hints of dried herbs and subtle floral nuances. It shows an earthy undertone along with mineral notes reminiscent of wet stones and graphite. On the palate, it showcases a rich texture with well-integrated tannins and a medium to full body. As it evolves, the wine reveals layers of complexity and depth, offering a lively and concentrated experience. Aged in 100% French Oak for 12 months, 33% of which were new.

THE WINERY. Established in 1988, Benton-Lane was born from the spirit of rugged individualism and relentless exploration. Benton-Lane is a 317-acre estate in southern Willamette Valley, planted on a historic sheep ranch and cloaked by thousands of forested acres. The 140-acre vineyard offers a mix of sedimentary and volcanic soils that provide a diverse opportunity for terroir expression, producing Pinot Noir with complexity and nuance. This wine originated in the beautiful LIVE Certified Maple Grove Vineyard, about 40 minutes Southwest of Salem, in the path of the cooling Van Duzer, where Dijon selection clones 96 and 75 were planted in 2014. The grapes were hand-harvested, whole bunch pressed and fermented and matured for 12 months in a selection of Francois Freres barriques. Thereafter the wine spent a further 6 months in stainless steel casks. This Chardonnay is taut and linear, with an impressive mineral core

THE WINERY. Hamilton Russell Oregon is a producer of carefully selected single vineyard Willamette Valley Pinot Noir and Chardonnay. It is owned and operated by Olive Hamilton Russell. She gained experience through decades long involvement in the world of wine, and played an active role in the management of Hamilton Russell Vineyards, Ashbourne and Southern Right wineries in South Africa. Mark's sense was that this was a unique block that should be made separately. 2023 is the first vintage; at only 0.9 acres, its yield of 1.1 tons/acre was tiny. Indigenously fermented with no SO2 in 33% new French oak, the wine is unfined and bottled by gravity.*

THE WINERY. *Mark Vlossak founded St. Innocent Winery in 1988. It was his desire to create wines respectful of old-world quality and tradition in Oregon's Willamette Valley, one of the newest and most exciting winegrowing regions in the world.*

In 2018, Mark purchased a 47-acre property in the South Salem Hills just off of the I-5 corridor. This move was inspired by Mark's desire to be a true vigneron: one who guides a wine's life cycle from seed to bottle. St. Innocent continues to produce vineyard-designated Pinot noirs from Momtazi, Temperance Hill, Shea and Freedom Hill Vineyards.

Owner/Winemaker Adam Campbell blended our best barrels from the old vine Pommard, 115 and 777 blocks of this site in the Laurelwood District of Oregon’s Chehalem Mountains AVA. This wine is an objet d’art, with a layered intensity of juicy blue fruit and turned earth, alongside dusty baking spice and cedar notes. Like fine caviar, it bursts in your mouth at precisely the right moment.

THE WINERY. One of the founding wineries of the Willamette Valley, family-owned and operated Elk Cove Vineyards was the first vineyard in the Yamhill-Carlton AVA. Second-generation Owner/Winemaker and fifth-generation Oregon farmer Adam Campbell sources fruit from Elk Cove’s six 100% estate-grown, sustainably farmed vineyard sites located across the northern Willamette Valley, specializing in Pinot Noir and cool-climate white wines. Elk Cove is named for the local herd of Roosevelt elk and the protective bowl shape of the property. Its tasting room is tucked into the foothills of the Coast Range, with spectacular views of the surrounding vineyards and mountains.

THE WINE. This singular selection represents the Antica Terra Vineyard in its purest form. Our inspiration came from Burgundy, where small producers would have often only one barrel from a small plot of Grand Cru vines and couldn’t bear to top it up with village level wine. They would drop small rocks into the barrel to displace the wine and eliminate the headspace. We waded through Alder Creek and picked buckets of rocks from the clear, newly-melted glacial runoff. This barrel was topped with these rocks and thus remains the purest expression of the distinction of this vineyard and its gifts.

THE WINERY. Antica Terra is one hundred and eighty-eight biodynamic-certified acres of native oak woodlands, gardens and seasonal waterways, planted to thirty-nine acres of grapevines. The vineyards are sited on a rocky hillside on the western foothills of the Amity Hills in the northernmost part of the Eola-Amity Hills. The first vines were planted here in 1989 in a clearing within the native oak savanna. The geology of the site is extremely unusual; in this place, the remains of a far older prehistoric seabed rise to the surface, leaving the vines to struggle, without topsoil, amongst a fractured mixture of sandstone sown with fossilized oyster shells.

The wine is produced from plantings from the original three blocks of Olson Vineyard, representing the oldest vines on the site, producing a complex wine layered with a balance of fruit, earth and soft tannins. THE WINERY. Torii Mor Winery was founded in 1993 by Donald Olson MD, who remains the owner to this day. Since its modest beginnings with just over 1000 cases, Torii Mor has blossomed into a ultra-premium winery that focuses on small lots of handcrafted vineyard designated Pinot Noirs. Winemaker Jon Tomaselli is passionately producing world-class Pinot Noir in the Dundee Hills of Oregon. With commitment to sustainability, Torii Mor has achieved LIVE Certification for both our Olson Estate Vineyard and our LEED Gold-Certified winery while continuing to craft high-quality complex wines that possess a quiet elegance.

THE WINE. This 2004 planted Dijon selection clone 115 Pinot Noir is grown in the idyllic LIVE Certified Zena Crown Vineyard in the Eola-Amity Hills. The fruit was hand harvested very early on the morning September 16th 2023. The wine has been matured in a selection of Francois Freres barrels for 19 months. This specially selected cuvee shows alluring dark berry fruit aromas followed by a savory spice driven palate. Lots of fine-grained tannin and a lively acidity bodes very well for further ageing.

THE WINERY. Hamilton Russell Oregon is a producer of carefully selected single vineyard Willamette Valley Pinot Noir and Chardonnay. It is owned and operated by Olive Hamilton Russell. She gained experience through decades long involvement in the world of wine, and played an active role in the management of Hamilton Russell Vineyards, Ashbourne and Southern Right wineries in South Africa. It is Hamilton Russell Oregon’s goal to express the very best attributes of Willamette Valley Pinot Noir fruit in a classical style emphasizing spice and structure, and Willamette Valley Chardonnay fruit in a bright, restrained mineral style.

THE WINE. Affectionately known as “J Hill” by the Domaine Serene Team, Jerusalem Hill Vineyard was planted in 2000 in the Woodburn series of soil, located in the Eola-Amity Hills region. This unique site is exposed to strong Van Duzer corridor winds, producing thick-skinned Pinot Noir with a savory streak. What sets this wine apart is its primary barrel fermentation and aging in 100% new French oak, a defining characteristic that led to its selection and separate bottling.

THE WINERY. Grace and Ken Evenstad founded Domaine Serene in the Dundee Hills of Oregon in 1989. Today, Domaine Serene produces wines from seven individual vineyard estates, planted exclusively to Pinot Noir and Chardonnay. In 2001, the Evenstads completed construction of their current state-of-the art, five-level, gravity flow Pinot Noir winery, which was followed by completion in 2018 of Oregon’s first white winery dedicated to the production of Chardonnay and sparkling wine. Domaine Serene’s wines represent the achievement that is possible in Oregon, one of the finest regions in the world for Pinot Noir and Chardonnay.

Belle Sœurs has always showcased the brighter and more lifted aromatics of any harvest, often superseding vintage generalizations. A small window into our most intimate duty, the constant pursuit of understanding the land beneath our feet, Belle Sœurs is a wine not to be missed and made to be shared.

THE WINERY. Beaux Frères encompasses three contiguous hillsides in the heart of Ribbon Ridge. The original 88-acre property was previously a foreclosed pig farm discovered in the local newspaper while on a family road trip in the summer of 1986. Michael G. Etzel, a young wine salesman alongside his wife Jackie and two small children (with a third child in the womb), went to view the property. After sharing the vision for the site with his sister Patricia and brother-in-law (“beau-frère”), esteemed wine critic Robert M. Parker, Jr., the two families purchased the property, transforming its pasture origin into a world-class vineyard site.

THE WINE. This wine showcases the vibrant, complex wines from our corner of the Chehalem Mountains, specifically our estate Quarter Mile Lane Vineyard. Our first vineyard planting in 1972, Quarter Mile Lane represents the inception of the Adelsheim story, and, more broadly, the evolution of Willamette Valley Pinot noir on the global stage. This south-facing site is planted at 680’ elevation on deep volcanic soils. Winemaker Gina Hennen selected Block 1 at 50 years old, and Block 16 (planted from cuttings of Block 1) at 15 years old. These “Blocks of Ages” are a viticultural juxtaposition merging history, legacy and modernity.

THE WINERY. Adelsheim Vineyard was founded in 1971 with a curious spirit and driven by a relentless pursuit of world-class winemaking in an undiscovered wine region. Since then, we have played an instrumental role in nearly every aspect of the Oregon wine story and continue to be one of the region’s most respected wineries.

As Chehalem Mountains’ first winery, our story began with 19 initial acres, to now 173 acres across 8 certified sustainable vineyards. Our mindful winemaking, led by Gina Hennen, reveals an authentic expression of Pinot noir and Chardonnay from the richly diverse soil types, elevations, and exposures of our home.

This estate bottling showcases a refined balance of energy, precision, and purity, unveiling layers of black fruit, subtle earthiness, and salinity. The minerality coming from this unique place will resonate in your palate and continue to evolve superbly with time.

THE WINERY. Founded in 2013, Résonance is Maison Louis Jadot’s first wine project outside Burgundy, France, since its inception in 1859. The name Résonance, meaning the same in both English and French, reflects the connection between Burgundy and the Willamette Valley. Specializing in distinctive Pinot noir and Chardonnay, each vintage showcases the unique terroir of three Willamette Valley appellations in Oregon. Winemaker Guillaume Large, originally from Burgundy, is dedicated to crafting exceptional, terroir-driven wines that authentically express their origins.
